## Marilyn Strickland Holds Strong Position in WA10


Results from a recent survey of likely voters<sup>1</sup>

After handily winning the primary in Washington's 10<sup>th</sup> Congressional District, Marilyn Strickland is in a strong position to win again in November. She holds a commanding lead over Beth Doglio: 43 to 22 percent with 35 percent undecided. Importantly, Strickland leads among Democrats, 61 to 28 percent. She also leads among Independents and Republicans and across every region in the district.

After balanced positive information on both candidates, Strickland surges while Doglio remains static. When voters hear more information about both Strickland and Doglio, undecided voters shift dramatically to Strickland. In a re-vote, Strickland leads Doglio 61 percent to 22 percent.



 $<sup>^{1}</sup>$  GQR conducted a poll of 400 likely general election voters. The poll was conducted via live dial interviewing from August 24<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup>. The survey has a margin of error of +/- 4.9 percentage points at the 95 percent confidence interval. Margin of error is higher among subgroups.
